

Sing Evensong at Southwell Minster - Saturday 3rd August 2019

As you might already be aware, when the regular choir at Southwell Minster aren't singing, visiting choirs are invited to sing in their stead. There is an available slot on Saturday 3rd August to sing Evensong, and BDCS have been given the opportunity to be the visiting choir for this service.

We would like to get a group together of ideally around twenty-two voices (but up to a maximum of thirty) from Bingham Choral, under Guy's direction, to be that visiting choir. The service will follow a prescriptive pattern of an Anglican Evensong service and might be more suited to those members of the choir that have experience of singing Evensong with their own church choirs, although that isn't a strict pre-requisite.

We will need dedicated rehearsal time to prepare for this, so its proposed that two Wednesday evening rehearsals (during the BDCS Summer break) on Wednesday 17th and Wednesday 31st July (say 7:15 – 9:00), probably at Carnarvon School if its available and cost effective; and then on the day of the service (Saturday 3rd August) from 2:00 – 3:30 in the Hoskyns room at Southwell Minster, and then 4:00 - 5:15 in the Quire, Southwell Minster. The service will commence at 5:30PM.

There will be costs involved to secure a rehearsal venue, accompanist, and Guys time, so would require a £20 contribution from each voice to cover costs (this might reduce slightly depending on final numbers singing). A small price to experience the joy of singing in the Quire at Southwell Minster!
